Range Q&A

1: When is the range open and when does it close?

A: The range opens when we open..so 10:00 am everyday but Saturday and on Saturday we open at 9:00 am. <u>YOU MUST BE AT THE RANGE BEFORE 4:50PM to shoot</u>...we close at 6:00 PM and need a few minutes to pick up. Anyone showing up after 4:50 will NOT be able to shoot.

B: If you have NOT signed up to shoot online remember that it will take some time to do so, we always recommend you do this from home although we do have a computer for you to sign up here if needed.

2: How much does it cost?

A: \$16 per person for one hours time, we do NOT have half hour pricing, If you become a member it is \$8.00 per hour and you get two targets.

3: How do I know if I qualify to shoot at the range? There are a few ways you can qualify to shoot at TopGun

a: You have taken a firearms safety course at some point in your life, Hunter safety does count. We offer classes and our Basic Firearms course would get you into the range.

b: You have been in or are or have been in: Any Military branch, Police/ Govt agency

c: You know someone who has shot here before and is willing to mentor you for the day (they will have to stand behind you when you shoot)

4: How old do I have to be to shoot at the range?

A: There is no age limit per se but you must be able to shoot over the bench without a stool and BOTH parents of children under 18 must sign our online waiver. A parent or guardian MUST be present while shooting.

5: Can you pick up your own brass?

A: Generally no, if you want to pick up what directly under your feet in your booth thats ok, but there is to be no picking through stuff on the floor or brass in buckets.
